PHYSICS DISTANCE LEARNING

Physics Distance Learning follows the Louisiana Science Content Standards and Physics Comprehensive Curriculum. It includes a conceptual and mathematical approach to: one and two dimensional dynamics, gravitation and rotational motion, momentum, work and energy, thermodynamics, waves, sound, light, and electricity and magnetism. The course requires students to complete chapter test, quizzes, solving problems, lab activities, and Internet projects. Students taking this course should have successfully completed Algebra I and Geometry. In addition, students should have two successful years of science. A third year of math is highly recommended. Successful completion of courses means a minimum grade of C in your math and science courses. This course is taught using Blackboard and Live Meeting video conferencing. There is one mandatory orientation meeting on Monday August 24th (4:15 pm - 7:00 pm) at the LCB Academy. In addition, there will be two or three Monday after-school lab sessions at the LCB Academy. The course will be broadcast to you at your home school during the school day. You may enroll in either the 2nd hour or the 6th hour class session.

Students enrolling in the Distance Learning Course will be assigned a laptop computer with the necessary hardware and software to participate in the Live Meeting component of the Distance Learning Class.
